EMERGENCY FLOOD REPAIR REGULATORY INFORMATION FOR PRIVATE PROPERTIES

Under normal circumstances, construction, facility and vegetation maintenance, and repairs within the bed and banks of streams on private property requires permits from Watershed Protection (https://www.onestoppermits.vcrma.org/departments/watercourse-encroachment) and up to 5 state and federal agencies. Under emergency circumstances, the same regulations apply, but the permitting processing (if needed) can take place during and after the emergency activities. It is best to contact the regulators before or as soon as possible after work needs to take place to protect life and property. Emergency work includes levee, bank, road, and utility line (water, sewer, power, etc.) repairs needed to prevent structures and roads from eroding into the riverbeds as soon as it is safe to do the work.

For emergencies, a list of local regulatory agency staff and links to permitting information is on page 2 of this document. In general, private landowners will need to provide a location map, parcel number, nature of the work needed/being undertaken, dates of damage, dates of repairs, conditions of the watercourse, photos, and other pertinent information. The work should be the minimum necessary to prevent further damage. A full repair may need to wait for both complete permitting and more favorable work conditions.
